

MEDITERRANEAN YOUTH MATHEMATICAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Rome, 17-19 July 2013

The MYMC has been promoted by MIUR, the Italian Ministry of Education, more precisely by its DG for the internationalization of research and by UNITN (Università degli Studi Internazionali di Roma), more precisely by its Mathematical Sciences Laboratory (LabSciMat).

It has been funded by the promoters as well as by INdAM and by ICTP, a UN institution.

It has been supported by UMI (Unione Matematica Italiana), Accademia Pontaniana, Piano Nazionale Lauree Scientifiche (PLS), and by three Mathematics Departments of the three major universities of Rome (Sapienza, Tor Vergata, Roma Tre).

The aim of the MYMC is to encourage Mediterranean youth, both male and female, to develop an interest in Mathematics.

All countries of the Mediterranean have been invited to participate in the MYMC and seven of them accepted: Cyprus, Italy, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine, Slovenia and Spain.

Each participating country has been represented by a team of four students, two boys and two girls, currently in their final three years of high school and at most nineteen years old. Each team has been selected by appropriate local entities.

The teams competed by solving various kinds of mathematical exercises. The four students of a team worked together towards the solution of the problems they were given.

The gold medal has been awarded on July 19 2013 to the Italian team (Federica Cecchetto, Alice Cortinovis, Davide Danesi and Fabio Marconi), the silver medal to the Spanish team (Miguel Barrero Santamaria, Gonzalo Cao Labora, Inés Franch López and Nuria Rodríguez Barroso) and the bronze medal to all the other teams with no distinction.
